Activities

In Coorg, students step into a living classroom where rainforests, streams, and farms become spaces for discovery. They learn how organic farming and sustainable practices shape communities, explore the biodiversity of lush forests and flowing waters, and take on the challenge of a ridge-top hike with sweeping views of the Western Ghats. The trip blends adventure with reflection, offering lessons that stay long after the journey ends.




Activities

Set against the backdrop of Kerala's lush landscapes, this trip invites students to slow down and immerse themselves in the wild. Days are spent watching birds in their natural habitat, paddling through quiet backwaters, and exploring the rich ecosystems that make Thattekad so unique. With Camp Hornbill as their base, students find both adventure and reflection in equal measure, returning with sharper observation, deeper curiosity, and a lasting connection to nature.







Accommodation

Hornbill Camp, Thattekad is situated in dense rainforest by the Periyar River, an hour's drive from Kochi Airport. Accommodation is simple, comfortable, and well-suited for student groups, with tents and cottages nestled deep in the woods. The camp offers a close-to-nature experience with activities like cycling through the bird sanctuary, canoeing on the river, and exploring the forests, making it an ideal base for learning and adventure in the outdoors.

Activities

Nestled in Uttarakhand's Himalayan foothills, Jim Corbett National Park, established in 1936, is India's oldest National Park, offering a haven for diverse wildlife, including Bengal tigers, elephants, and various bird species. The adventure extends to the charming village of Kyari on the Tiger Reserve's periphery, providing students an experience of the Kumauni way of life. Kyari's community actively engages in farming, handicraft weaving, and fish farming, promising students an immersive journey filled with natural beauty and cultural exploration.







Accommodation

Nestled within the Sitabani Conservation Reserve near Corbett National Park, Camp Hornbill is a community-led eco-retreat run by locals from Kyari village. Built using eco-friendly materials like mud, thatch, and woods sourced from the area, it offers a simple, nature-immersed stay that blends seamlessly into the forest. The camp brings the outdoors to life, inviting visitors on guided forest walks, birdwatching, jungle hikes, cycling, village walks, and more. It is also rooted in conservation and rural development, supports local livelihoods, wildlife protection, and an authentic engagement with Kumaoni culture.

Mukteshwar, Uttarakhand

Perched in the quiet village of Sunkiya near Mukteshwar, Camp Sunkiya offers students a balance of adventure and cultural immersion in the Kumaoni Himalayas. Outdoor activities like rock climbing, bouldering, flying fox, and archery provide an exciting introduction to mountain exploration, while time spent with the local community offers a glimpse into traditional farming, cooking, and village life. Students also contribute meaningfully to the restoration of the Sunkiya village school: painting classrooms, organizing libraries, and enhancing sports facilities - making this journey a blend of learning, adventure, and community service in the heart of Uttarakhand.

Tucked away in the quiet Sunkiya village near Mukteshwar, Camp Sunkiya is a community-rooted eco-camp run by locals. Its tented setup blends naturally into the Kumaoni mountain village and is powered by sustainable practices like solar energy and eco-friendly construction. Guests can join in immersive experiences—from rappelling and valley crossings to guided nature walks, bird watching, and fireside storytelling. Cultural activities invite visitors to participate in local farming, cooking, and even treasure hunts inspired by The Amazing Race.

Chorla Ghat, Goa

Activities

Chorla Ghats, set in the picturesque Western Ghats landscape of Goa, serves as a crucial wildlife corridor between the Bhimgad Wildlife Sanctuary and the Mhadei Wildlife Sanctuary. Forest hikes along the river and exploration of laterite plateaus provide a beautiful outdoor experience for students. Visits to sacred groves and nearby villages offer a unique opportunity to explore the rich local culture and savor the authentic cuisine of the Mhadei region. Students also get a chance to observe diverse wildlife, including birds, reptiles, and small mammals, in their natural habitats.

Rishikesh, Uttarakhand

September | Grades: 9-12 | 5 nights, 6 days | Camp Aquaterra



Activities

The Rishikesh program, is designed to combine three exciting and challenging activities. It begins with a three-day hike to Pau ki Devi and Dashrath ka Danda, followed by a kayak and raft trip in the valley of the Upper Ganges. The final leg involves a raft sprint downriver, where participants steer the rafts themselves, requiring teamwork and combined paddling skills. Based out of moving accommodations, with each leg presenting a unique challenge, this program is ideal for students seeking an adventurous and immersive experience.







Accommodation

During the trek and river adventure, students stay in comfortable alpine and campsite tents. Nights are spent on high ridges with panoramic Himalayan views, near the hill village of Ranakot, at Beas Ghat along the river, and at riverside camps like Camp Silver Sands. Campfires, shared meals, and simple tented arrangements provide a safe, immersive experience in nature while allowing students to rest and prepare for the day's trekking and rafting activities.

Tons Adventure Trek, Uttarakhand

September | Grades: 9-12 | 5 nights, 6 days | Tons Camp



Activities

The Tons Adventure Trek takes students through the secluded Tons Valley, combining trekking, village interaction, and river rafting. Along the journey, students stay in a mix of tents, dormitories, and simple rooms at Camp Bagi, Saras village, and the Balcha grasslands, offering a close-to-nature experience. Trekking through alpine forests, meadows, and remote villages, students witness local life and participate in community service, before finishing with an exhilarating rafting trip on the clean, alpine Tons River. The blend of adventure, learning, and immersive outdoor stays makes this an unforgettable experience in the Himalayan foothills.







Accommodation

Throughout the Tons Adventure Trek, students stay in a variety of simple, comfortable arrangements that connect them with the surrounding landscape. At Camp Bagi, they experience tented stays with basic facilities, ideal for riverside and forest activities. In Saras village, accommodation is provided in rooms, dormitories, or tents, offering an authentic glimpse of remote village life. The trek also includes overnight camping on the Balcha grasslands, and concludes with a hotel stay in Mussourie for comfort and rest before departure. Each stop balances immersion in nature with safe and practical arrangements for student groups.

Nagarhole, Karnataka

Year-round | Grades: 6-9 | 3 nights, 4 days | Jungle Inn



Activities

The school trip to Nagarhole combines conservation, wildlife, and hands-on nature learning at Liana, a 14-acre conservation farm near Hunsur set up by herpetologist and adventurer Gerry Martin. Students explore mini ecosystems, track wildlife, birdwatch, and learn field biology techniques like pug casting, trail camera surveys, and microscope work. Outdoor skills such as bamboo raft building and cooking challenges are paired with animal care activities, tending to cows, goats, ponies, reptiles, and birds. A safari in Nagarhole National Park adds an exciting wildlife experience!







Accommodation

During the trip, students stay at Jungle Inn, a comfortable wildlife resort located about 30 minutes from Liana Farm. Rooms are shared among 4–6 students, each with en suite bathrooms, providing a safe and cozy base after days of exploration and learning. Meals are wholesome and multi-cuisine, fueling students for activities ranging from safaris to outdoor skill challenges. Liana Farm itself offers an immersive natural setting for daytime learning and hands-on experiences, with its mini ecosystems, animal care areas, and activity zones complementing the experience.

Activities
